ID Rules

Each person must bring ONE piece of Government issued photo-id (passport OR EU photocard driving licence OR EU citizens ID card).

AND ONE other proof of address from the following list

- Financial statement (bank, credit card, mortgage, student loan, store card).
- If a passport is used for photo-id, the driving licence can be used as proof of address.
- Benefit statement from DWP.
- Electoral register (electoral roll).
- Tax statement from HMRC (not P60, not P45).
- Council tax bill.
- Local authority (not private lender) tenancy agreement.

Proof of address in joint names is acceptable.

Photocopies are NOT acceptable, nor are printouts from the Internet.

Generally, proof of address must be recent (issued with the last three months) unless they are recognised annual (eg mortgage, student loan)

No substitutes are acceptable.
